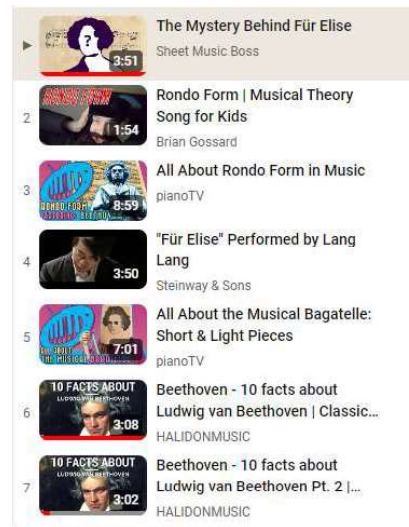
Fur Elise
